The trial calendar is prepared based on the previous ready list and trial calendar.
U.S.C.R. 8.2 and 8.3

Unless a case is continued or specially set by the Court, it is the responsibility of the parties to call or email the secretary of Judge Rumer, to

(a) determine the current position of their case on the calendar,

(b) inform the Court as to the status of the case including whether a settlement appears imminent and an estimate of how long a trial will take; and

(c) CORRESPONDINGLY, DETERMINE WHETHER, SINCE THEIR CASE IS THEN IN THE FIRST TEN CASES ANNOUNCED READY OR PLACED ON THIS DOCKET AS READY FOR TRIAL, THEY WILL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE THEIR CASE READY FOR TRIAL WHEN COURT STARTS MONDAY, JUNE 18, 2018, AT 9:00 A.M.

Please recall that all cases should be mediated before trial. Failure to mediate will not be a ground for continuance, and it may result in sanctions, including striking of pleadings, dismissal of the case, and imposition of attorney fees. See Standing Order, Ex Parte No. 17-501, filed November 21, 2017.

The positions of cases on the trial calendar often rapidly and drastically change. It is the position of the case on Monday, June 18, 2018, that will control any decisions of the Court. If the Court does not assign a case to be ready for trial on Monday morning, June 18, 2018, by placing it within the first ten cases ready for trial, then the counsel or parties will be responsible for contacting the office of Judge Rumer each afternoon of the bench or jury trial term to find out when they should report for trial. If your case is close to being within the ten cases ready for trial, then be mindful and attentive to its position moving up. Each afternoon by 4:00 p.m., the first ten cases ready for trial the next day will be posted on the Clerk's website, and counsel will be notified by email as to the calendar.

Where cases are settled or to be dismissed, notify the Court by Friday, June 15, 2018, and submit the final documents to the Court for signature AND filing in the Clerk's Office within THIRTY-ONE (31) DAYS from the day of the notification. If notification is sent to the Court that a case has settled or will be dismissed, and the final documents have not been filed by the thirty-first (31st) day, then the Court will dismiss the action.

UNDER THE UNIFORM SUPERIOR COURT RULES, IF A PARTY FAILS TO ANSWER WHEN THE COURT CALLS THEIR CASE DURING THE COURT TERM, THE COURT MAY DISMISS THE CASE, ANY CLAIMS, OR A PARTY'S PLEADINGS. It is also the attorney's duty to be sure that the secretary of Judge Rumer has the attorney's accurate telephone numbers, mailing addresses and email address. If the party is pro se, that is, the party representing himself/herself without an attorney, then it is the party's duty to check on the status of the case as above stated and to keep the secretary of Judge Rumer informed of the party's accurate telephone numbers and mailing addresses.

FAILURE TO HAVE A COURT REPORTER PRESENT TO REPORT YOUR CASE MAY AFFECT AN APPEAL FROM THE RULING OF THE COURT

IT IS THE DUTY OF THE PARTY SEEKING TO HAVE A CASE REPORTED TO CONTACT THE JUDGE'S SECRETARY PRIOR TO THE DAY OF THE HEARING TO REQUEST A COURT REPORTER'S PRESENCE IN COURT.

UNLESS THE PARTIES AGREE TO SHARE THE COSTS OF HAVING THE CASE REPORTED, THE REQUESTING PARTY MAY BE REQUIRED TO PAY THE ENTIRE AMOUNT OF THE COURT REPORTER'S FEES.

Counsel may contact Ashley Yates to make arrangements for the court reporter to be present. You must make the request no later than June 18, 2018. Trial shall not be delayed because counsel did not make arrangements with the Court Reporter prior to the trial beginning.

NOTE: It is your duty to keep yourselves informed about when your case will be tried. The above-required communications will inform you about when the case will be tried, and it will help the Court in properly using the trial days.
