ADDENDUM NO. 1

Repair and Refinishing of Countertop Workstations at Muscogee County Jail RFB No. 18-0034

Vendors are informed that the referenced Request for Bids (RFB) is hereby modified, corrected or supplemented as specified, described and set forth in this Addendum.

I. BID DUE DATE:

The bid due date is extended. Sealed bids must be received and time/date stamped by the Finance Department/Purchasing Division no later than 2:30 PM on Wednesday, March 20, 2018.

II. SPECIFICATION CHANGE:

As a result of the Mandatory Site Visit, amendments to the specifications are listed below.

- A. The contractor shall have 20 plus years of experience with countertop installation and construction.
- B. The contractor's base of operations shall be within a 100-mile radius of Columbus, Georgia.
- C. The contractor shall have a job Superintendent on-site from beginning until the jobs conclusion, and the jail command staff gives written or electronic acceptance of their job performance.
- D. Fabrication and construction will be done on-site within the secure perimeter parking area behind the jail.
- E. Everything within the Control Rooms will remain in operation.
- F. The existing countertops will be removed and replaced.
- G. The new countertops will be constructed from 3/4 inch AC interior plywood, and laminated to match radius.
- H. The Control Room counter radius will remain, but with new laminate applied over old, that is equal to or better than old laminate.
- I. Support studs will be every four (4) feet.

- J. Support studs will be made out of steel (20 gauge), 1 1/2 inch by 3 1/2 inch (2x4 inch wood equivalent), and wrapped with 1/2 inch AC interior plywood for stability and painting.
- K. Support studs under both control panels will be vertical to floor, 48 inches apart, and attached at the outer edge away from radius.
- L. The remaining support studs will be installed based on ADA standards (sloped to allow non-interference by chair(s), with no less than an 18 inch slope to point.
