## NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The **<u>Consolidated Government of Columbus, Georgia</u>**, has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes in the following taxing districts:

Urban Services District #1, #5, #6, #7	4.00 percent
Urban Services District #2	9.00 percent

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are to be held in the Council Chambers on the second level of the City Services Center, 3111 Citizens Way, Columbus, Georgia 31906, on <u>June</u> <u>21, 2022 at 9:00 a.m.</u>

This tentative increase in Urban Services Districts #1, #5, #6, #7 will result in a millage rate of <u>16.68 mills</u>, an increase of <u>0.622 mills</u>. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than <u>16.058 mills</u>. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of <u>\$175,000</u> is approximately <u>\$35.14</u> and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of <u>\$225,000</u> is approximately <u>\$55.98</u>.

This tentative increase in Urban Services Districts #2 will result in a millage rate of <u>10.70 mills</u>, an increase of <u>0.869 mills</u>. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than <u>9.831</u> <u>mills</u>. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of <u>\$325,000</u> is approximately <u>\$101.24</u> and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of <u>\$225,000</u> is approximately <u>\$78.21</u>.
