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MODULAR BUILDING CODE COMPLIANCE GUIDELINES

Plan review and permit requirements for modular (pre-manufactured) buildings and attached entrance decks, stairs, ramps and structures.

Construction documents for all pre-manufactured buildings shall be reviewed and approved by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) to indicate compliance with the Industrialized Building Act. <u>Verification of DCA approval is required</u>.

Requirements and permitting procedure:

- 1. Completed Building permit application.
- 2. Moving permit.
- 3. Approved site development permit.
- 4. 2 copies of DCA approved plans to include:
 - A. 2 copies of building floor plan drawn to scale.
 - B. 2 copies of foundation plan drawn to scale.
- 5. 3 copies of the site plan drawn to scale.
- 6. Fire Hydrant Certificate Per Fire Prevention.
- 7. All other trade permits (plumbing, mechanical, gas & electrical) as applicable.

CONSTRUCTION DRAWING REQUIREMENTS

- All drawings must be drawn to architectural or engineering scale.
- Since most pre-manufactured buildings are elevated above grade, a porch/deck with stairs and an accessible ramp is required. The construction documents shall include complete porch/deck, stair, and ramp details. The details shall include foundation details, handrail and guardrail details, and deck framing details.
- The building must comply with accessibility and life safety requirements.
- Digital plan submittal is also required.

NO BUILDING PERMIT REQUIRED FOR CONSTRUCTION TRAILER

• Job trailer must get Lights & Power permit for electrical use.
