

# **PUBLIC MEETING ANNOUNCEMENT**

The Columbus Consolidated Government, with the Columbus-Phenix City Metropolitan Planning Organization, invites you to participate in a virtual public open house for the J.R. Allen Parkway Corridor Study. The purpose of this study is to analyze J.R. Allen Parkway/Beaver Run Road (US-80) from the Flat Rock Rd/Kitten Lake Drive to the western end of the US-80 bridge over the Chattahoochee River. The focus of this analysis will be on addressing traffic congestion, determining the opportunities and constraints involved in bringing J.R. Allen Parkway to interstate standards, and improving the infrastructure available for bus, pedestrian, and bicycle traffic.

J.R. Allen Parkway is a critical corridor for the cities of Columbus and Phenix City. Therefore, input from the community is important to ensure that improvements address deficiencies, maximize opportunities, and meet current and future needs of those living, working and traveling along and through the corridor. The study team has prepared a website with information related to the recommended highway and multi-modal improvements that were developed in response to your comments from the previous virtual workshop. Your comments on these recommended improvements would be greatly appreciated.

Your input is vital for the City of Columbus, Georgia to establish a shared vision and lead to the successful implementation of the study in future phases when funding is available.
