B. City's response to the following submitted request for clarification:

1. Question: "Would you accept 19' flat with 6' beavertail?"

Response: **The user department would accept that set up as well.**

2. Question: "Would you accept 235/16 tires?"

Response: **Yes.**

3. Question: "By dual, do you mean 4 tires or 8 tires?"

Response: **4 tires, one on each side of the axle and there will be two axles under the trailer.**



4. Question: “*Since there is no such thing as an 8,000K dual axle, would you accept 10-ton duals?*”

Response: **Yes.**

5. Question: “*Would you accept 8,000# SINGLE axles, not duals? (This will give you the GVWR and tire size you’re looking for.)*”

Response: **Yes. Dual axle means 2 single axles under the trailer with one tire on each side of each axle.**

NOTICE TO DEALERSHIPS: The Columbus Fleet Management Division is authorized by most major manufacturers to perform warranty work and will be reimbursed for both parts and labor at the agreed upon hourly rate between the manufacturer and the City of Columbus. If an agreement on a maker of trailer has not been established the trailer will be sent to the nearest authorized location for warranty work to be performed. Copies of the manufacturer’s warranty on the manufacturer’s letterhead must be submitted with the bid.	

NOTE: A copy of the manufacturer’s warranty must be included with the bid response.
