A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE ALABAMA SECTION OF THE 2021 - 2024 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) AND THE 2045 METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN (MTP)

WHEREAS the Governors of Georgia and Alabama have designated the Columbus Department of Planning as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Columbus-Phenix City (C-PCTS) urban area; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to amend the Alabama section of the 2021 – 204 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and the 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) to add the following project for Smiths Station; and

• P.I. No 1000 – Widen (shoulder rehabilitation) and resurface Lee Road 296 from Lee Road 430 to Lee Road 298. CST Cost - \$149,972.25. This project will be funding with the CARES Act / Coronavirus Relief Fund.

WHEREAS, this roadway is not listed on ALDOT's Functional Classification Map, therefore, the City of Smiths Station will need special permission from ALDOT to resurface this roadway with these federal funds; and

BE IT RESOLVED that the Columbus-Phenix Transportation Study Policy Committee approve the amendment of the 2021 - 2024 TIP and the 2045 MTP to add this project.
