AMENDMENT

COLUMBUS-PHENIX CITY TRANSPORTATION STUDY POLICY COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE 2021-2024 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) AND THE 2045 METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN (MTP)

WHEREAS the Columbus-Phenix City Transportation Study (C-PCTS) Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the organization designated by the Governors of Alabama and Georgia as being responsible, together with the State of Alabama and Georgia, for implementing the applicable provisions of 23 USC 134, 135 (as amended by the FAST ACT Sections 1201, 1202 July 2012); 42 USC 7401 et seq.; 49 USC 5303, 5304; 23 CFR Parts 450; 40 CFR Parts 51 and 93; and,

WHEREAS it is necessary to amend the 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and the 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) to include the following Performance Targets and the System Performance Report; and

- PM 1 Safety Performance Targets for Georgia and Alabama (The MPO adopted the ALDOT and GDOT Safety Targets in January 2023). The Safety Targets are required every year.
- PM 2 Bridge and Pavement Condition Performance Management Targets (The MPO adopted the ALDOT and GDOT Targets in May 2023). The Bridge & Pavement Targets are required every four (4) years.
- PM 3 Travel Time Performance Targets (The MPO adopted the ALDOT and GDOT Targets in May 2023). The Travel Time Targets are required every four (4) years.
- System Performance Report

WHEREAS the Performance Targets and the System Performance Report are required to be included in the Transportation Improvement Program and the Metropolitan Transportation Plan.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Columbus-Phenix Transportation Study Policy Committee approve the amendment of the 2021-2024 TIP and the 2045 MTP.
