DPH Guidelines to Prevent Spread of COVID-19

Potential Guidelines for Courts

- Deep clean entire building
- Increase cleaning and disinfection after each day
- Offer multiple sessions to accommodate social distancing of at least 6 feet
- Do not hand out paper-based information
- Provide hand sanitizer
- Encourage elderly and medically fragile individuals to stay home
- Encourage only the person required for court to attend (hospitals have a NO guest policy)
- Ensure that everyone is wearing a mask (provide masks for those who don't have one)
- Mark floors as a visual cue for social distancing
- Remove/arrange furniture to support social distancing
- Keep an online meeting option
- Use a screening tool to screen everyone entering the building for exposure to a COVID-19 positive patient, or any symptoms of the virus or illness
- Screen everyone for fever
- Post signs about non-contact greetings
- Limit bathroom use and control the number of users at one time
