Agenda Discussion

I. Welcome

Chester Randolph, LCWDB Chair

Howard Pendleton, WIOA Director

The following is a summary of the discussion as it pertains to the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 and the responsibilities conferred upon the local workforce area, which comprises the eight-counties of Chattahoochee, Clay, Harris, Muscogee, Quitman, Randolph, Stewart and Talbot, and the cities and municipalities contained therein. These minutes, in accordance with the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act, contain motions presented for approval. A sufficient number of members were present to satisfy a quorum for voting. These minutes are open for public viewing and made available upon request.

The meeting was called to order by Chair Chester Randolph with a welcome and a request for introductions from those present.

Mr. Randolph began discussion by thanking the attendees for their presence. He continued by stating the importance of attending the board meetings for 4 of our members have had to be removed due to non attendance and the process had begun to fill those vacancies.

After thanking everyone again for their attendance, the Chair asked if there were any questions or discussion regarding the June 15, 2017 minutes (A Copy is attached to original minutes as permanent record). There being no discussion, the Chair asked for a motion to approve the minutes as written.

Action Taken:

Tony Calloway so moved and Joe Lee Williams properly second, approval was granted by majority of all active board members in attendance to approve the minutes as written for June 15, 2017.

II. Approval of One-Stop Certifications

Mr. Pendleton informed the board that under WIOA it was required to certify each of the one-stop centers in a local area (both the comprehensive and all affiliate sites) our LWDA has seven total – one comprehensive located down at the GDOL (700 Veterans Parkway) and six affiliates. Mr. Pendleton gave a brief overview and discussion of the certification criteria and how the appropriate staff conducted the process. The certifications have been done and confirmed by our CLEO, we just need the board to approve them as well.

The Chair asked if there were any questions or discussion. There being no further discussion, the Chair asked for a motion to approve the one-stop certifications.

Action Taken:

Carolyn Hugley so moved and Carl Brown properly second, approval was granted by majority of all active board members in attendance to approve the one-stop certification at presented.

III. Approval of By-Laws Changes

Mr. Pendleton informed board members that during the State's review of our Board Certification Report they cited two issues that were not stipulated in the by-laws and were required in order to remain in compliance with Federal regulation. An amendment summary had been included in your packets for review. We've amended the by-laws to incorporate these items as required.

The first amendment was under Article III, Section (B) VACANCIES, now the third paragraph includes Georgia Rule159-2-1.05(5) which states a LWDB member shall be automatically removed and replaced for failing to attend three (3) consecutive board meetings without cause. Mr. Pendleton noted it was required to removed four board members due to non- attendance and those positions were in the process of being filled.

The second amendment was under Article VI, Section III which reads as follows, "Members to serve on each standing committee shall be voluntary and shall consist of board members and include other individuals appointed by the board who are not members of the board with an expressed interest and optimum knowledge or expertise in the area represented." Mr. Pendleton noted that the process for filling a non-board member slot on each of the board's committees had begun.

Mr. Pendleton asked if there were any questions or discussion about the changes to the By-Laws. The chair again stressed the importance of attending the meetings and asked if there were any questions or discussion regarding the amended by-laws. There being no further discussion, the Chair requested a motion to approve the by-laws as amended.

Action Taken:

Carolyn Hugley so moved and Tony Calloway properly second, approval was granted by majority of all active board members in attendance to approve the by-laws as amended.

IV. Approval of Adoption to EPL

Mr. Pendleton informed the Board that there was additional information requested from a Vendor (CSUCE) that required their request for EPL adoption to be tabled until the next board meeting in December. Their request would be presented to the board at that time.

V. Presentation by Georgia Tech

Kenya Harrison, Georgia Tech

Mr. Pendleton reminded the board that we currently had the Vet² Program through the Operation Transitioning Military Assistance Grant funding that wasn't a part of our regular formula funding and had already had several successful outcomes for participants that had gone through the program. Mr. Pendleton introduced Mr. Kenya Harrison from Georgia Tech. Mr. Harrison gave a presentation of their full array of Programs of Study for Veteran's and provided an overview and discussion (A Copy of the material presented is attached to original minutes as permanent record). A lengthy discussion ensued with several inquiries being made regarding the participants (once completed) staying in our community rather than relocating in other parts of Georgia or out of state altogether.

The Chair noted that additional enter-action with local businesses was needed to generate more interest in taking advantage of personnel completing this training and utilizing their talents for the betterment of our community. The Chair stated the APOC Committee needed to convene and research our area for that enter-action with the businesses and industry here and then report back to the board. Therefore, voting to include the Vet² of study presented here today in our regular formula funding would be tabled until a later date to allow further research.

The Chair asked if there were any other questions or discussion. With no further discussion, the Chair thanked Mr. Harrison for the good works they were doing and for providing the presentation of their programs of study and stated the board would notify them when this item would be on the Agenda for discussion and approval.

Action Taken: No action taken.

VI. Financial Report

A report of the WIOA Local Area Grant Summary broken down by youth/adult/dislocated worker/rapid response funds was provided to Board members for discussion. (A Copy is attached to original minutes as permanent record). Mr. Pendleton provided a brief overview and discussion of awards and expenditures.
