Agenda Discussion

I. Welcome Chester Randolph, WDB Chair

The Chair began with introductions and a welcome to all members.

The following is a summary of the discussion, which contains motions presented for approval. A sufficient number of members were present to satisfy a quorum for voting.

The Chair requested a motion to approve the March 17, 2016 Board Meeting minutes as written (a copy is attached to the original minutes as permanent record).

Action Taken:

Tony Calloway so moved and Joe Lee Williams properly second, approval was granted by majority of all active board members in attendance to approve the March 17, 2016 minutes as written.

II. Financial Report

Howard Pendleton, WIOA Director

A report of the WIOA Local Area Grant Summary broken down by youth/adult/dislocated worker/rapid response funds was provided to Board members for discussion. (A copy is attached to original minutes as permanent record). The WIOA Director provided a brief overview and discussion of awards and expenditures.

III. PY16 Grant Award and Allocations

The WIOA Director gave an overview of the analysis of Grant Award and Allocation by grant (a copy is attached to original minutes as permanent record).

IV. Approval of PY16 Contracts

Board members were reminded the option for renewal of the In-School Youth (lower counties) and Out-of-School Youth with Special Needs (Muscogee Co. only) contracts had expired. To ensure equal opportunity for other bidders in the area, authority was granted at the March 17th Board meeting to publish Request for Proposal of Program Year 2016 Services with the same number of participants to be served under WIOA. Mr. Pendleton informed the Board an intent to Bid had been published April 10, 2016 which included notification of public release of Request for Proposal. County publications were also coordinated on or before April 10th. Proposal packets were made available to the public from April 18th to May 13th. Only one letter of intent to bid was received, one from Operation MEN the current provider of the In-School Youth Services for the lower counties.

Mr. Pendleton noted due to the lack of response from the Intent to Bid published, Operation MEN was deemed a "Only Known Source" therefore a formal proposal wasn't required of them. Unfortunately, no response was received for our Out-of-School Youth with Special Needs (Muscogee Co. only) Program. Our current Contractor has struggled with personnel changes, and potential participants not wanting to come forward with required information on the ISS and disability they receive making it extremely difficult to get a client through the process to become an active participant in the program. With the difficulties they've experienced, they felt it was best not to submit a proposal for the upcoming year. Mr. Pendleton further noted that with no proposals for this program being received, a contract would not be awarded at this time.

A brief discussion ensued, concerns were voiced about not having a program serving youth with special needs. Mr. Pendleton assured the Board that a solicitation would be re-advertised in the future.

Mr. Pendleton gave a brief overview of the contract awards recommended broken down by fund, Solicited and Unsolicited Youth Services; renewal of the specified adult and dislocated worker services and the unsolicited in-house adult and dislocated worker services for Program Year 2016 with renewal options where applicable based upon WIOA regulation, performance and funds availability (A copy is attached to the original minutes as permanent record). Prior to discussion and voting April Hopson and Jaime Loyd abstained from discussion and voting.

The Chair asked if there were any questions, there being no further discussion a motion was presented to approve the contract awards as recommended in the Agenda Packets for Program Year 2016.

<u>Motion Presented</u>: Request Board approve contract awards for Program Year 2016 as recommended with renewal options where applicable based upon WIOA regulation, contingent upon funds availability and contract performance.

Tony Calloway so moved and Beverly LaMee properly second, approval was granted by majority of all active board members in attendance to approve the Contract awards for Program Year 2016 as recommended.

V. Military Grant Assistance Award

Mr. Pendleton informed the Board that three applications had been submitted in response to the State's RFA for additional grant funding. Only one of the applications had been approved, the Operation Military Transitioning Assistance Program for a total of \$300,000.00 being awarded for the period of 05/01/2016 through 04/30/2018. Mr. Pendleton noted that the program would be coordinated through Columbus Technical College and Mr. Jaime Loyd would be working on the contract for the program.

Mr. Jaime Loyd gave a brief overview and discussion of the necessity of the program, the program design and the partners that would be involved in the delivery of services to ensure the program's success. The Program expectations were discussed.

Action Taken:

VI. WIOA Update

Mr. Pendleton informed the Board that historically, it's never taken this long to receive the regulations for new legislation that had been passed and signed by the President. He believed the upcoming elections was factoring into the delay as well as all the different agencies now involved in the in-put. Each Agency was trying to ensure their agency was provided for delaying the whole process.

Mr. Pendleton noted that moving forward, we will continue to do what we're doing until such time the regulation is received and we will make the necessary changes as required to remain in compliance with the new legislation.

Mr. Pendleton stated he would keep the Board informed on any new developments

VII. Local and Regional Plan

Mr. Pendleton informed the Board that a RFP had been published for our Local and Regional Plan with a \$25,000.00 with no responses. Therefore, we have decided to go with Jim Livingston with the RDC to work on the plans for us. The comment period will be in August.

F & L Nurse's Aide Program Martha P. Hollis, LPN: Primary Instructor 7000 Storage Court #4 Columbus, Georgia 31907

Program of Study:

Certified Nurse's Aide Program & CPR

TRAINING LENGTH: 5 weeks; 141 total hours (57 curriculum hrs; 49 lab hrs & 35 clinical hrs) 5 days per week (30 hrs – 1st 13 days; 28 hrs – next 7 days & 35 hrs last 5 days).

TRAINING COST: \$1,397.00 (includes tuition, supplies, books, uniforms, shoes, tools, medical exam, PPD test, drug screening, background check and state certification exam and CPR exam)

COST OF COMPARABLE PROGRAM: Proposed training costs are competitive to comparable training in local workforce area.

Motion to Approve inclusion on State Eligible Provider Listing at full cost of training for WIOA eligible clients that includes requirement for State certification exam and CPR exam. Require that client must have met school entry requirements prior to WIOA approval.
